

WHO REPORT FOR FREE MOBILE CONSULTATION From September to November 2022

Caritas Kumbo in partner with World Health Organization (WHO) in a bid to reduce excess morbidity and mortality of affected population in the North West regions of Cameroon (Diocese of Kumbo) through emergency humanitarian assistance, visit some communities in Bui Division for free consultation and medications to the affected populations of the Anglophone crisis present in these communities. This program target mostly people living with disabilities, internally displace persons, old and the vulnerable who are sick and can't afford for basic medical needs.

The beneficiaries are identified by health centers or hospitals of the community through community health workers of the said locality and also with the religious personnel who go round to pray for the sick persons. We were able to reach out to **1,259** beneficiaries. During consultation people were identified with different illnesses such as gastritis, dental caries, ear and eye infections, mental cases, arthritis, Upper Respiratory Tract Infection (URTI), people leaving with disabilities etc.
